At this time the County doesn't have an ordinance regulating how digital displays are used when visible from the road. To avoid distracting traffic, the Public Works Department recommends that the sign be used to display "static" messages (no moving graphics); and that when multiple static messages are used that the rotation be no quicker than 5 seconds.
