Healthy Moms include group treatment, individual therapy, psycho-education on parenting and recovery, childcare, case management, art therapy, and a breakfast program. The atmosphere of the program is designed to be nurturing and family-oriented, and clinical interventions are consistently strength-based and trauma-informed. The overall goal of the program is to help empower women to break the cycle of addiction and abuse.

The donation shall be used for the purchase of holiday gifts for children of program participants.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Donation in the amount of \$750.00 was received from Eureka Rotary. With this donation, current balance of donations in County trust for the Healthy Moms Program is \$969.69. These donation revenues and associated expenditures have been included in fiscal year 2016-17 adopted budget for Healthy Moms Program budget unit 1180-431. There is no anticipated County General Fund impact.
