Private Sector seats require a formal nomination by an open-membership business organization (i.e., a chamber of commerce or a professional or business organization such as Kiwanis or Rotary), a business trade association, or an agency board of directors. Labor Union seats require a formal nomination from a local labor federation. All other seats require no formal nomination. Your nomination must be secured prior to submitting this application by completing Part III below.
