I have lived in Eureka, since May of 2019. Prior to that I lived in Port Hueneme, CA where I retired in 2013 after a career of of 33 years as a civil servant with the Department of Navy retiring as a GS-14.

I was a member of the Ventura County Air Pollution Control District Advisory Committee from 2005 until 2009. My duties included advising regarding permits, inspections and compliance, regarding the planning for air monitoring, rule development, and overhead.

I was the Enterprise Operations manager for the Navy Facilities Engineering Command overseeing expenditures of roughly 5.3 million dollars for annual contractual agreements for Information Assurance, Operational help desk, and Quality Assurance and Monitoring.

I was a board member of the CBC Federal Credit Union from 2015 until 2018 representing the Supervisory Committee; overseeing audit functions and evaluating fraud risk, and reviews of internal controls.

While serving on the Ventura air pollution citizens advisory committee I was able to review and offer insights into public and private businesses regarding controls and effectiveness of ambient air pollution efforts and safe guards. I found this work interesting and hopefully helpful to the communities.

My interest in serving on the citizens advisory committee regarding Measure Z expenditures revolves around accountability and representation for the improvement of public safety and essential services. Such as 911 response times, investigations of violent crimes and rural fire protection and ambulance services.
