Community Choice Aggregation Program

<u>RECOMMENDATION(S)</u>: That the Board of Supervisors hear the presentation and take appropriate action, if required.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) is a system adopted into law in the states of Massachusetts, New York, Ohio, California, New Jersey, Rhode Island, and Illinois which allows cities and counties to aggregate the buying power of individual customers within a defined jurisdiction in order to secure alternative energy supply contracts on a community-wide basis, but also allowing consumers not wishing to participate to opt out.

CCA's now serve nearly five percent of Americans in over 1300 municipalities and are de facto public utilities of a new form that aggregate regional energy demand and negotiate with competitive suppliers and developers, rather than the traditional utility business model based on monopolizing energy supply.

In California, Community Choice has become part of the state's strategy to achieve climate change goals, with a focus on green power rather than merely energy discounts. As of 2015, over twenty five cities and three counties have created or joined a CCA in California.
