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# RESOLUTION EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY FIRE SAFE COUNCIL

WHEREAS, this resolution affirms the intent of the County of Humboldt to expand the membership of a collaborative, countywide Fire Safe Council that will oversee the maintenance and implementation of the Humboldt County Community Wildfire Protection Plan ("CWPP"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors recognizes the value of maintaining and implementing the countywide CWPP for the development and implementation of community fire safe programs and activities between public agencies, <u>non-profit organizations</u>, <u>local Fire Safe Councils</u> and private sector landowners/participants within Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, this resolution recognizes that the development of community-based CWPPs is a concept born out of the <u>California</u>statewide Fire Safe Council whose mission is to <u>be "California's leader in community wildfire risk reduction and resiliency" mobilize all "Californians to protect their homes, communities and environments from wildfire;" and</u>

WHEREAS, the <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors recognizes that the formation and maintenance of a <u>County feountywide</u> Fire <u>S</u>safe <u>C</u>eouncil furthers the goals of the National Fire Protection Association's Firewise Communities program which encourages local solutions for wildfire safety by involving homeowners, community leaders, planners, developers, firefighters and others in the effort to protect people and property from the risk of wildfire; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors supports the continuation of the Humboldt County Fire Safe Council to serve as a forum for the implementation of the measures outlined in the CWPP, share fire-safety related information, assess fire risk, promote community fire-safe planning and coordination, link fire-prevention programs, <u>support beneficial fire (prescribed fire, cultural burning, and managed wildfire where appropriate)</u> and support the fire service <u>(including local volunteer fire departments and companies)</u> and local <u>Ffire Ssafe Ceouncils/Firewise Communities</u>; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors, through the <u>creation\_continuation</u> of the Humboldt County Fire Safe Council, shall encourage the development of local <u>Ffire Safe Councils or other similar groups</u> dedicated to reducing the vulnerability of communities to damaging wildfires <u>and promoting fire-safe</u>, <u>A</u> activities <u>shall take place</u> in accordance with management principles which protect and enhance the forest, range, and watershed values of our coastal, interior valleys, and mountain ecosystems.

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors hereby <u>extends expands</u> the <u>term membership</u> of the Humboldt County Fire Safe Council <u>for an additional sixty (60) months from the date of adoption of this resolution</u>, subject to the following provisions:

#### A. ESTABLISHMENT OF FIRE SAFE COUNCIL:

A committee for the County of Humboldt, to be known as the Humboldt County Fire Safe

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Council, <u>has been</u> established pursuant to Section 26152 of the <u>California</u> Government Code is hereby extended.

#### B. <u>PURPOSE</u>:

The purpose of the Humboldt County Fire Safe Council is to oversee the maintenance and implementation of the CWPP, of concern to the County of Humboldt and, when appropriate, to inform and make recommendations to the <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors.

#### C. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF MEMBERS:

The committee shall consist of sixteen eighteen (186) members; fifteenthirteen (153) of which shall be voting members and three (3) of which shall be non-voting members:

- 1. Three (3) non-voting members shall be appointed as follows: The Public Works Director or designee shall act as liaison for communication between the committee and the <a href="https://example.com/Humboldt County">Humboldt County</a> Board of Supervisors and one (1) member from <a href="each-both">each-both</a> the Six Rivers National Forest and the Bureau of Land Management shall act as federal liaisons.
- 2. Five (5) of the voting members shall be appointed as follows: each member of the <a href="Humboldt County"><u>Humboldt County</u></a> Board of Supervisors shall appoint one (1) member. Such members need not reside in the supervisorial district of the appointing Supervisor. <a href="Hittps://district.org/lengths.com/Hittps://district.org/lengths.c
- 3. Four (4) of the voting members shall be appointed at-large by a majority of the <a href="Humboldt County"><u>Humboldt County</u></a> Board of <a href="Supervisors">Supervisors</a> shall appoint three (3) representatives from local <a href="Fire Ssafe Ceouncils or Firewise Communities">Firewise Communities</a> and one (1) representative from a local fire protection organization.
- 4. Four Six (64) of the voting members appointed shall include one (1) representative nominated by each of the following agencies and organizations: Humboldt County Fire Chiefs Association—; California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection—; Hoopa Valley Tribe and/or other tribetribal organizations—; and the Humboldt County Office of Emergency Services; the University of California Cooperative Extension; and the Humboldt County Prescribed Burn Association.
- 5. All voting members shall serve terms that shall commence on the date of their appointment and shall expire sixty (60) months from the date this resolution No. 16-119 was is adopted by the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors. The committee voting members shall serve at the pleasure of the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors. The voting members shall designate a Chair and Vice-Chair from the voting members.
- 6. A designated alternate shall be appointed for each voting member and serve terms that commence on the date of their appointment and expire sixty (60) months from the date this rResolution No. 16-119 wasis adopted by the Humboldt County Board of

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Supervisors. Alternates shall vote only in the absence of their associated FSC Fire Safe Council member.

#### D. <u>FUNCTIONS</u>:

The Humboldt County Fire Safe Council shall serve in an advisory capacity to the <u>Humboldt</u> County Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt in accordance with the following guidelines:

- 1. The committee shall oversee the maintenance and implementation of the CWPP and consider related Fire Safe Council matters within the authority of the <u>Humboldt County</u> Board of Supervisors.
- 2. The committee shall encourage development of local volunteer <u>Ffire Ssafe Ceouncils</u>, <u>Firewise Ceommunities</u>, or other similar wildfire preparedness groups, and broad voluntary participation on the part of the local fire safe councilsthese such groups, private landowners, non-profit organizations and public agency partnerships.
- 3. The committee shall provide support for the pursuit of funding that meets one (1) or more of the goals and objectives outlined in the CWPP.maintain and update criteria for the evaluation of projects that are eligible for funding under the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act, Title III, as such funding becomes available.

## E. <u>MEETINGS</u>:

- 1. The committee shall hold quarterly meetings at the call of the Chair at such place as is designated by the Chair. More frequent meetings may be held, or subcommittees may be formed and hold meetings, as necessary to ensure a consistent effort to implement the measures outlined in the CWPP.
- 2. A special committee meeting may be called at any time by the Chair. Such special meeting shall be effective for the transaction of business only if a quorum is present. Only subject(s) mentioned in the call of such special meeting shall be considered at the meeting.
- 3. Seven Eight (87) voting members of the committee shall constitute a quorum. No official action may be taken by said committee without a quorum.
- 4. All meetings of said committee shall be open to the public. Subject to reasonable restrictions by the Chair as to order of presentation, length of time and subject matter, any person may be allowed to express himself at a committee meeting regarding business of the committee.

#### F. REMOVAL OF MEMBERS FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS:

A committee member absent from three (3) consecutive scheduled committee meetings without appropriate and reasonable excuse may be removed from the committee for such absence and a new member may be appointed pursuant to the appointment provisions of this resolution.
