Bayville Care encourages the Planning Commission to deny the Local Coastal Development Permit and the Entertainment Permit for the Old Academy Road Improvement Project because it violates the County's Local Coastal Plan (Sections 2.18 and 2.20).

Four significant historic properties (the 1902 county clerk's school, the 1902 Temperance Hall, the 1941 George Bayville Community Hall & the 1976 Larchmont "White House") are all associated with an extensive recorded archeological site at Bayville Care. There are no proposed mitigations for the adverse effects to the Setting and historic "View North" of the Boardwalk as contained in the preliminary historic location.
