Whereas, the Boys & Girls Clubs week, comprised of Boys & Girls Clubs of America, together reach millions of youth via their services and community involvement; and

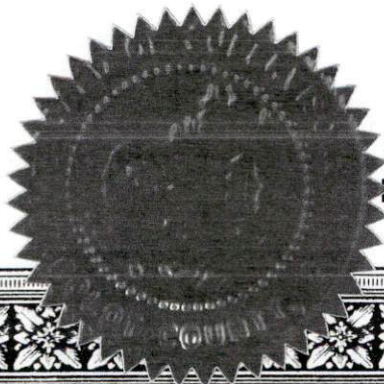
Whereas, the Boys & Girls Clubs Week emphasizes the importance of academic success, healthy lifestyles, community involvement and artistic expression.
