There will be a maximum of two harvests annually. Historic cultivation occurs in four distinct cultivation areas and the proposed project includes relocation of two cultivation areas to environmentally superior locations. The applicant is also proposing to reorganization 25,136 square feet of full-sun outdoor cultivation into greenhouses. There are four greenhouses in two cultivation areas totaling 11,475 square feet that will be used for propagation. Annual water use is 417,550 gallons. Water is sourced from a permitted well.
