Dear Humboldt County Planning Commissioner Thomas Mulder;

I hope this email finds you well,

I wanted to discuss the comments you made at last night's Planning Commission hearing (2/3/2022) during Humboldt Hempire Farms, LLC, Record No. PLN-2020-16602, APN 223-061-011 Garberville Area. During this permit application, in part, you claimed that the actions made by the Planning Commission and Planning Director triggered what you claimed was "PTSD", reliving having "guns in your face by law enforcement". This came from a request that enhanced monitoring be conducted on the project site, that a site inspection be conducted twice a year with no notification or announcement of the site inspection (enhanced monitoring) by the Planning Department, not law enforcement.

Have you been diagnosed with PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder) by a medical doctor? Does PTSD limit your mental capacity or ability to make decisions because of this medical condition as a Planning Commissioner?
