# RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 6. Direct the Clerk of the Board, within 5 working days, to submit a copy of all responses to the County Clerk/Recorder, together with a copy of the original report; and
- 7. Direct the Clerk of the Board, within 5 working days, to submit two copies of all responses to the Clerk of the Court, one of which will be forwarded to the State Archivist, together with a copy of the original report.

- "A Growing Concern" (Attachment 12). The Grand Jury has requested responses from the Board of Supervisors, the Planning & Building Department, Treasurer-Tax Collector and the Auditor-Controller.
