My name is Sonny Anderson I have resided in the Petrolia area since 1973. I have with me a petition signed by more the 300 people asking the county to put at least 20 to 25 percent of Measure Z funding to resurface our roads.

This money should be divided equally among the five districts.

I also have a letter from the principal of the Mattole and Honeydew schools who is concerned about unsafe roads.

On July 22, 2014 the resolution from the board that day stated the need for the ½ proposed sales tax because the county needed to fund law enforcement, fire and roads. The measure Z ballot stated that some measure Z money was for our county roads.

In 2015 public works applied for 630,000 to go to our roads and for some reason that request was denied.

In June of 2015 the board was informed the sheriff could not fill positions that were approved by the committee and board and the board decided to give 480,000 of measure Z money to public works, to my knowledge public works has only spent around 350,000 of that money on the roads and as of this date no more measure Z money is available for the roads.

One has to ask why are our unsafe roads being funded under measure Z with the same vigor that the law enforcement and fire are being funded why does sheriff and fire have a seat on the advisory committee and the road department does not.

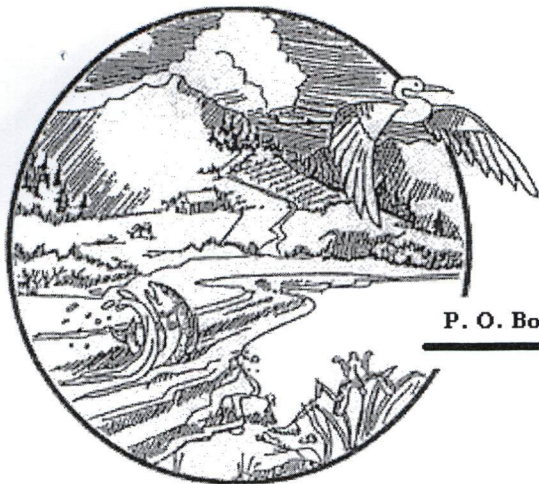
Most people stand behind the road department 100 percent on any funds they request from measure Z or the general fund if it goes to resurfacing or maintain the surface of our roads.

People are upset that the county under some protest from the public converted stable paved areas back to gravel, I and others request that the county ask public works to change this policy of converting our paved roads back to gravel. This should only be done if the paved road is in an active slide area or the intent is to chip seal the gravel area immediately. I spoke with Art Reeve yesterday and he informed me that sections of Lighthouse were converted back to gravel because the county wanted to reshape the road, sorry but the overall design of the road has not changed.

There was a meeting on Lighthouse road with Art Reeve, Bennie and members of the public and we were told that the paved areas were going to be converted back to gravel because "gravel roads are easier to maintain then paved roads.

I asked Mr Reeve if the county would change its policy on turning paved roads into gravel and not convert stable roads to gravel and he would not agree to change that policy I think it is time for the board to ask the road department to change that policy and allocated the needed funds to the road department to maintain the surface of our roads so we have safer roads and no longer have to convert another stable paved road to an even poorer gravel road.

To Whom it May Concern (i.e. Humboldt County Citizens Advisory Committee on Measure Z and Humboldt County Board of Supervisors):

As the principal of both elementary schools (Honeydew Elementary and Mattole Elementary) and the high school (Triple Junction High School) and as a 25 year resident of the Mattole Valley, I would like to address the issue of the current appalling state of our local county-maintained roads. Our roads are a huge safety hazard. There are giant potholes all along the 15 miles of road between Honeydew and Petrolia, especially in the Lindley and Grange areas. Vehicles often cross the yellow line to avoid the holes on blind turns creating the possibility of head-on collisions. Our school bus travels Mattole Road twice daily and I feel that we are putting our youngest residents (our schoolchildren) in great danger every day as they travel back and forth to school. Our bus route also includes Lighthouse Road in Petrolia which is in great disrepair. I live on Wilder Ridge in Honeydew and must travel across the dirt switchbacks and the 'Landergeren Slide' (which is barely passable now and appears to be bound to completely slide away at any time) twice daily.

I have had numerous conversations of late with our local residents. We realize that the Sheriff's department has been underfunded but this has also been the case for county roads. Our roads have been neglected for years. Please allocate 25% of the available Measure Z funds to resurfacing our county-maintained roadways.

I attended the January 14th meeting of the Advisory Committee to the Board of Supervisors where the allocation of the "Measure 2" funds was discussed.

As I understood, the Public Works Department requested \$1,500,000 but only received \$630,000 in 2015.

I am asking Public Works to request the allocation of \$1,500,000 for 2016 in addition to the 2015 funds that were not used. (The \$1,500,000 figure should be a minimum annual allocation.)

The allocated "Measure 2" funds should be divided equally between the five districts for resurfacing roads. (The roads that have been ripped and back to gravel are the worst.) It is a pleasure to drive on the resurfaced spans.

Thanks in advance for requesting funds and repairing the roads to a safer condition.
