



SUMMARY: 315-174-003-000 Jalal Tahir

In support of Law Enforcement Operations on August 09, 2021, at approximately 08:45, I accompanied the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) on a Search Warrant for parcel number 315-174-003-000, located on USFS Route 1. Other agencies on scene were the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), AP Helicopter, National Guard, US Ranger Service, Counter Drug Task Force, and County Hazmat. Once the area was secured for entry, I entered the property and conducted a site inspection on behalf of Humboldt County Code Enforcement where I verified and documented the violations of Improper Storage and / or Removal of Solid Waste, Unpermitted Well, Use of a Recreational Vehicle as a Residence, Unapproved Sewage Disposal System, Construction in Violation of Building Codes, Grading without Permits, and Violation of the Humboldt County Commercial Cannabis Land Use Ordinance (CCLUO).

I immediately noted a well on the road allowing access to the rest of the property. At time of inspection, it did not have a pump attached to it but it did appear to a recent well as no dirt or weathering was apparent on the cement pad surrounding the caisson / riser. Research found no permits for the well constituting a violation of unpermitted well. Had a water line been attached to the riser, a violation of non-approved water supply system would have been noted.

Area 1

I then made my way to the cannabis cultivation operation on the property. The operation was taking place on a graded area (Graded Flat 1) near the center of the property. Graded Flat 1 measured approximately 14,300 ft 2 in area, had a high geo instability rating, and was found on a slope listed as 15 – 50%. I also noted Greenhouse 1 was on a separate terrace than Greenhouses 2 and 3, and a 10′ foot cut bank was located on the Northwest side of the flat.

Any graded area where excess of 50 cubic yards of earth is moved, or is in a moderate to high geo instability area, or has a 15% or greater slope, or is created for the placement of structures upon it requires a grading permit. Since no such permits associated with this parcel were located, a violation of unpermitted grading is warranted.

I documented three (3) greenhouse structures (Greenhouses 1 -3) built from PVC conduit using wood for bracing on Graded Flat 1. Each of the greenhouses were found to have raised beds filled with soil containing pearlite. Greenhouse 1 was void of cannabis at time of inspection, but on the adjacent property to the North (315-173-004-000), also owned by Jalal Tahir, I located a wooden structure (Dry Shed) filled with hanging cannabis. Since all other greenhouses located on the properties still had growing cannabis within, this suggests the

cannabis from Greenhouse 1 was harvested and placed into the Dry Shed for processing. Details of the greenhouses can be found in the "Locations of Interest" section below.

Only Six (6) cannabis plants per permitted residential structure, per parcel is allowed per California State Ordinances, and Humboldt County Code, without the proper County Permits and State Licenses. Additionally, any structure measuring 120 ft² or larger in size requires a permit per Humboldt County Code 331-11. Since no permits were found associated with this site, violations of unpermitted structures and the CCLUO were noted for each greenhouse.

Surrounding Graded Flat 1, I also noted two (2) Recreational Vehicles (RV) and multiple structures being utilized. One RV was found to have been empty and according to HCSO staff, was until recently on its side. The other RV was being used as a residence so a violation of such was noted.

The three (3) structures located on site were all constructed of wood and had a pier-and-post foundation. There was an Outhouse, Shower (Building 1), and residence (Building 2). Also surrounding Graded Flat 1 were multiple piles of solid waste. Although the structures found are below the 120 ft² threshold requiring a building permit, the purpose for which the structures were being utilized also requires a permit. For this reason, violations of unpermitted sewage disposal system and violations of the Building Code were noted. Further details of these items are in the "Locations of Interest" section below.

315-173-004-000

Area 2

I then headed to the next Parcel (315-173-004-000) located North of 315-174-003-000. This parcel is also owned by Jalal Tahir and consists of two (2) areas, each with greenhouses and supporting infrastructure for the cannabis cultivation operation.

Area 2 is found on the Southern part of the parcel and encompasses two (2) graded flats (Graded Flats 2 and 3), each with a greenhouse upon it, and a few wooden buildings. Graded Flat 2 measured 7,700 ft² in area and Graded Flat 3 measured 8,600 ft². Both had a high geo instability rating and were found on slopes listed as 0 - 30%.

The two (2) greenhouses (Greenhouse 4 on Graded Flat 2 and Greenhouse 5 on Graded Flat 3) located in Area 2 are of the same construction as those found in Area 1 on parcel 315-074-003-000. Each contained flowering cannabis standing 3' - 6' feet in height placed in raised beds. Measurements and details of Greenhouses 4 and 5 are located in the "Locations of Interest" section below.

To the West of Greenhouse 4, I located a wooden structure (Dry Shed) measuring 640 ft² in size. The Dry Shed was filled with bucked cannabis plants hanging from metal lines spanning the width of the building. Additionally, I noted electrical and venting installed throughout the

building. Again, any structure measuring 120 ft² or larger in size requires a permit per Humboldt County Code 331-11. Since no permits were found associated with this site, violations of unpermitted structures were noted.

Moreover, all the greenhouses located on this property, Greenhouses 4-8, were filled with growing cannabis. The only greenhouse found during the service of this warrant where the cannabis plants were harvested, was located on the adjacent parcel 315-174-003-000. As stated before, both parcels have the same property owner. This suggests the unpermitted cannabis cultivation operations occurring on both parcels are part of one larger operation.

Just behind the Dry Shed, to the West, I located another wooden structure (Building 3). Building 3 measured 64 ft² in size and was being utilized for storage of wood.

Slightly to the North of these buildings, I located another Outhouse building, as well as a shower (Building 4). This is an additional violation of unpermitted sewage disposal system. The Outhouse and shower swill have to be removed and the pit filled in for the violations to be abated.

I also documented a set of water tanks (Water Tanks 1) consisting of two (2) tanks with a total capacity of 5,600 – gallons.

Area 3

Area 3 is found on the Northern part of the parcel (315-173-004-000) and consists of one (1) graded flat (Graded Flat 4), with three (3) greenhouses (Greenhouses 6 - 8) upon it. Graded Flat 4 measured 14,800 ft² in area, has a high geo instability rating and was found on a slope listed as 30 - 50%.

Once again, any graded area where excess of 50 cubic yards of earth is moved, or is in a moderate to high geo instability area, or has a 15% or greater slope, or is created for the placement of structures upon it requires a grading permit. Since no such permits associated with this parcel were located, a violation of unpermitted grading is warranted.

The three (3) greenhouses located in Area 3 (Greenhouses 6, 7 and 8) were also of the same construction as those found in Area 1 located on 315-174-003-000 to the South and Area 2 of this parcel. This suggests the cannabis cultivation operations in all three (3) areas are related and not being performed by separate individuals. They all contained budding cannabis standing 3' - 4' feet in height placed in raised beds. Additional details are located in the "Locations of Interest" section below.

On the South side of Graded Flat 4, I documented set of water tanks (Water Tanks 2). The set of three (3) water tanks had a total capacity of 7,500 – gallons and appeared to be feeding the cannabis cultivation located here.

I also noted several piles of solid waste throughout both properties. CDFW and Water Boards personnel found an illegal point of diversion used to fill the water tanks supplying the cannabis cultivation operation.
