WHEREAS, Wayne Hanson began his career with the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff in 1976; and

WHEREAS, Wayne was hired by the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office as Correctional Officer I on August 21, 1983; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 1986 Wayne resigned his position as a Correctional Officer II in order to accept his appointment to Deputy Sheriff effective January 4, 1987; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 1993 Wayne was transferred to the Marijuana Enforcement Team and participated in many enforcement operations through the State of California Campaign Against Marijuana Planting (CAMP); and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 1994 Wayne was appointed to Sheriff's Corporal/Field Training Officer (FTO) and was responsible for the training of newly appointed Deputy Sheriff's; and

WHEREAS, while assigned as Corporal, Wayne was called on numerous occasions to fulfill the role of Acting Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1997 Wayne was promoted to Sheriff's Sergeant on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1999 Wayne was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division supervising the Drug Enforcement Unit, where he served for a total of 12 years investigating marijuana related crimes and other complex style investigations including, homicides, burglaries, assaults, and other related crimes; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2012 Wayne was promoted to the rank of Sheriff's Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, during his 40 years of service Wayne received countless commendations and letters of support for his efforts while serving the citizens of Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, Wayne also earned the respect of his peers and co-workers for his dedication and hard work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, Sheriff Mike Downey and the staff of the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office hereby commends and thanks Lieutenant Wayne Hanson for his dedicated 40 years of service to the citizens of Humboldt County and wish him and his family a long, productive, well deserved retirement.
