POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, DIVISION 1, TITLE VII (COMMERCIAL MARIJUANA CULTIVATION TAX) OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE

On Tuesday, October, 2020, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors approved adoption of an Ordinance amending Title VII of the Humboldt County Code relating to the Commercial Marijuana Cultivation Tax Ordinance.
Amendments to the Commercial Marijuana Cultivation Tax Ordinance sections 719-4, 719-6, 719-7 and 719-12 of Chapter 9 of Division 1 of Title VII of the HCC are intended to ensure that commercial cannabis taxes due in any given year will be paid on a timely basis. This ordinance is intended to restore the provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 1 of Title VII of the Humboldt County Code as they read before the adoption of Ordinance No. 2575 and to eliminate reference suggesting property owners who are not permitted cannabis cultivators have an obligation to pay the tax due under that chapter.
