**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVENUE OF THE GIANTS AND CONTROLLED TRAFFIC ON MATTOLE ROAD TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF RUNNERS PARTICIPATING IN THE SIX RIVERS RUNNING CLUB'S 53<sup>rd</sup> ANNUAL AVENUE OF THE GIANTS MARATHON, HALF MARATHON AND 10K RACE ON SUNDAY, MAY 4, 2025 BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:30 AM AND 2:30 PM**

**WHEREAS**, the Six Rivers Running Club is planning the 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon, Half Marathon, and 10K Race for Sunday, May 4, 2025 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, road closures and controlled traffic are necessary to ensure the safety of runners participating in the marathon.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, on Sunday, May 4, 2025:

1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to a point 6.55 miles south of the Dyerville Bridge. During the event Highway 254 will be closed to all traffic except for official race support and emergency vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home would also be allowed to pass.
2. Both lanes of Mattole Road will be controlled by Wes Nalley Stop N Go traffic support pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders' Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on Mattole Road.
