ORDINANCE NO. 682

## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FISH AND GAME ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Humboldt do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEE. The "Fish and Game Advisory Committee of the County of Humboldt" is hereby established.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE. The Committee shall consist of fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Supervisor of each district shall appoint two (2) members, and the remaining five (5) members shall be appointed at large. The two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 1, 2 and 3 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1973. The two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 4 and 5 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1971. Three (3) of the five (5) members appointed at large shall be appointed for a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1971, and the remaining two (2) members at large shall be appointed for a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1973. All subsequent appointments shall be for a term of four (4) years and shall expire on June 30 of the fourth year after appointment. Members of the Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE OF COMMITTEE. The Committee is established to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors in all matters concerning fish and game within the County of Humboldt.

SECTION 4. MEETINGS. The Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings at such time and place as shall be agreed upon by the Committee, and such other special meetings as shall be required from time to time. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Committee, or, in his absence, by the Vice-Chairman of the Committee.

SECTION 5. REMOVAL OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS. In the event that any member of the Committee shall absent himself from three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the Committee without showing good cause therefor to the Chairman, at the fourth such consecutive regular meeting from which he is absent his place shall automatically become vacant. Such vacancy shall be reported to the Board of Supervisors, and the Board of Supervisors shall appoint another member for the unexpired term of the member whose absence gave rise to the vacancy.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its enactment.
