Revised Bid Authorization Date for the Juvenile Hall Replacement Facility Construction

Project, Project Number 170212

<u>RECOMMENDATION(S)</u>: That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Clerk of the Board, upon the Director of Public Works obtaining State approval to Proceed to Bid, to advertise the Juvenile Hall Replacement Project, pursuant to Section 22037 of the California Public Contract Code, on June 14, 2016, with bids to be opened on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at 2:00 PM;

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Criminal Justice Construction Fund, Board of State and Community Corrections Senate Bill ("SB") 81; Local Youthful Offender Rehabilitative Facility Construction Funding and Certificates of Participation.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: In 2007, SB 81 (Chapter 175, Statues of 2007) established the Youthful Offender Block Grant Program to enhance the capacity of the counties to provide appropriate rehabilitative and supervision services to youthful offenders. In 2011 the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors initiated the acceptance of a grant with the State of California for the SB-81 Juvenile Hall Replacement Project.

The project design and contract documents pertaining to the Juvenile Hall Replacement Project are complete and ready for bidding. All prerequisite plan reviews and approvals are also complete. Accordingly, once the the State of California issues a Notice to Proceed to Bid, the County may begin the bidding process for the Juvenile Hall Replacement Project in accordance with the conditions of the grant.

On May 31, 2016 (C-19), the Board authorized advertisement for bid of the Juvenile Hall Replacement Project on June 7, 2016, contingent upon the Director of Public Works receiving the State's Notice to Proceed to Bid. State approval has not been received by the Director of Public Works in time to allow advertisement of the project on June 7, 2016. Therefore, the dates for advertisement for bid must be revised as listed above.

The total authorized Construction Budget for the Project is \$14,242,018, which includes contingencies. The Architect's estimate for construction, not including contingencies, is \$13,477,348. The Grant offer received from the State is a fixed amount of \$12,930,869, which is specifically for the construction portion of the Project.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: As stated in the agenda item dated December 8, 2015 (H-5), the impact to the General Fund will be \$773,500 and up to \$1,326,480 for ten percent (10%) Bid Overage Margin totaling approximately \$2,100,000. On January 19, 2016 (H-3), the Board directed the Treasurer/Tax Collector to secure additional funding of \$2,100,000 for the potential project adjustment. On April 14, 2014 (C-9), the Board committed by way of resolution grant match funding of \$900,000 from the Criminal Justice Construction Fund and \$2,319,625 from a 20-year bond. This placed the total funding by the County to approximately \$5,319,605. The recommended action will not result in a financial impact at this time.

The recommended action conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Strategic Framework Core Roles of providing for and maintaining county infrastructure.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: Board of State and Community Corrections

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board could choose not to revise the bid release date for the Juvenile Hall Replacement Project. However, this is not recommended since doing so could cause the loss of funding scheduled and provided by the State program.
