Temporary closure of two branch libraries of the Humboldt County Library due to

an all-day planned power outage by Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E).

### RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors approve the temporary closure of the Kim Yerton Memorial Branch Library in Hoopa and the Willow Creek Branch Library in Willow Creek on Wednesday, September 17, 2014 due to a planned power outage by PG&E.

# SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Library Fund.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Kim Yerton Memorial Branch Library in Hoopa and the Willow Creek Branch Library in Willow Creek will be without power for an entire day due to a planned power outage by PG&E. The Library has determined that it could present a hazard to both the public and the staff members to work inside these facilities when they are without power. It is recommended to close these sites during this planned power outage and if possible re-assign staff members to other locations.

Because this closure is due to a PG&E power outage the County Library staff members affected by the closure will be paid whether they report to work or not and so the County Library will find other locations for the affected staff members to work on the planned day of closure.
