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

HUMBOLDT BAY TRAIL SOUTH (APN
501-241-005 & 404-141-002)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Government Code section 25350, that on September 1, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing to receive public comment and testimony regarding the proposal for Humboldt County to acquire real property as described below.

The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors intends to consider approving the acquisition of two parcels (Assessor Parcel No. 501-241-005 and 404-141-002) to be used for construction of the Humboldt Bay Trail South Project. The parcels under consideration are situated along the Humboldt Bay shoreline between Brainard and Bracut. The parcels are used for billboard display and railroad infrastructure. The North Coast Railroad Authority holds an easement over the parcels for railroad purposes. The parcels would be acquired from Allpoints Outdoor Inc. and Thomas/Gretha McMurray, willing sellers, with state transportation funds for the sum of \$600,000. The purpose of the acquisition is to acquire a portion of the right-of-way necessary for development of a Class 1 bike path (multi-use trail) connecting Arcata and Eureka.

Any and all interested parties are invited to participate in the hearing and provide public comment. The hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 1, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard. In accordance with Executive Order N-29-20, this meeting will be held virtually.
