Board of Supervisors,

I want to register my strong support of Supervisor Madrone's objection to the board's endorsement of the CalTrans project that would permit STAA trucks to drive through Richardson Grove State Park (RGSP).

I join many other residents of Humboldt County in the belief that this project requires more careful analysis of the inevitable consequences of increased truck traffic on the park and, equally important, on our communities along 101. Interregional and interstate truck traffic can have economic benefits but also quite significant detriments to our still somewhat pristine environment and our towns along the roadway. Further degradation of this environment must be avoided for our sakes and for the sake of posterity.

I also believe that the environmental impacts of the proposed project have not been fully analyzed, and it is important to recognize that using the data from the impacts on the ancient redwood root system, were the project to go forward, as important for understanding potential impacts on possible future projects is a very weak argument for destroying the old growth root system within the RGSP.

I am appreciative that the proposed revised, 'neutral,' language has removed the vague reference to strengthening to our county's public health. I strongly urge you to take up Supervisor Madrone's objection, to go beyond the proposed new/neutral platform, and adopt a platform that does not support the CalTrans project.

The ramifications of increasing traffic on 101 have not been addressed by CalTrans.

Since the ramification raises both Federal and local issues, both EIS and EIR processes are required to consider and determine alternatives, feasible mitigations and overriding considerations.

CalTrans once proposed to minimize damage to Richardson Grove by building two bridges which also shortened the highway and straightened the alignment, thus demonstrating the feasibility of this alternative.

Esteemed chair and Humboldt County Supervisors,

My comments are in regards to your December 15, 2020 Board agenda item 1, File #20-1619 (2021 Legislative Platform). I do not support the current County 2021 legislative platform.

I found out that after 13 years of litigation between different organizations, the Environmental Protection Information Center (EPIC) and The Center for Biological Diversity, the Ninth Circuit reversed EPIC's lower court victory. All this time local American Indians, other environmental organizations and community members were pleading Caltrans not to destroy Richardson Grove State Park. I sent a card in support of Richardson Grove 12 years ago. I am sure I was not the only one that did that. I have driven through that area many times and am deeply touched every time I am surrounded by these giant redwoods.

This highway-widening project would slice through the root systems of the grove's ancient trees, damage the roots of more than 100 of Richardson Grove's ancient redwoods, including trees up to 3,000 years old, 18 feet in diameter and 300 feet tall. They provide crucial habitat for old-growth-dependent species like the endangered marbled murrelets. Vanishing salmon and steelhead still return to the park's streams to spawn. Successive ice ages, including the last one that ended about 10,000 years ago, have restricted the remaining redwood species to three small, distinct regions, each supporting one of the species. Each region is the only place in the world where you will find native populations of that species. Redwoods are not just trees — they are part of complex communities of living things interacting with their environment. These ecosystems depend on redwoods and support these trees. I understand that about 82 percent of the remaining ancient coast redwood forests are protected in parks and reserves. Caltrans' further destruction of Richardson Grove State Park to widen the highway is inappropriate and unlawful. They have pursued this project solely to incrementally improve passage for heavy, oversized commercial trucks, with trailers up to 53 feet long.

Tourists from all over the world as well as locals are driving through this area in awe of this iconic, breathtaking environment. Tourists do not come to admire giant Surface Transportation Assistance Act (STAA) trucks. This area is one of the environmental gateways in California where conservation and preservation of the native flora and fauna need to take priority over greed to create a wide thoroughfare from San Diego to Crescent City.

Widening the highway to allow extra-large trucks to use Highway 101 would adversely affect the local and regional North Coast economy by increased reliance on out-of-area transportation companies resulting in loss of local businesses and jobs. A less environmentally damaging alternative to the Caltrans project already exists in Highway 299 that links Humboldt County to Redding, the main north-south rail corridor and Interstate Highway 5. Hundreds of millions of dollars were spent to improve 299. This Caltrans project would create, for the first time ever, a North-South route for giant STAA trucks, coinciding with another major realignment on Highway 199, along the Wild and Scenic Smith River. Together they would create a new circuit linking Interstate 5, Highway 299 to Redding, Highway 101 north and south, and 199 to Grants Pass.

These STAA self contained trucks would pass through and by Humboldt, generating unsafe road conditions, pollution, noise, vibration, accidents, and road damage, affecting multiple communities and the environment, 24/7. Not incidentally, the added truck traffic would foster new development all along the Highway 101 corridor. As development follows this newly accessed route, so will traffic, causing a cascade of inter-related and unevaluated impacts, including sprawl in heretofore "under-developed" areas from Sonoma north to Oregon. There would be no more "Redwood Curtain."

At the state level, Caltrans has not yet completed the new public

comment and review period mandated by the state court. Until they do so, the project cannot move forward.

The project to widen Highway 101 remains the subject of major litigation, which will likely stop the project, and therefore no urgent reason exists for your Board to support the project or put it on the County's priority list for 2021.
