

Schneider Coastal Development Permit Modification

I understand this meeting is about a Coastal Development Permit and a Special Permit Modification.

I am submitting this statement to make known the egregious actions I have experienced.

I have the Parcel K Trail Easement which really should have been for all the peoples of Humboldt County.

I have watched the development of the Mid-County Ranch subdivision since the late 1980s.

In 2006, I recieved deeded access to the Parcel K of the Mid-County Ranch subdivision. I have used the Trail/Easement since 2007.

In Sept 2016 a fence was installed blocking access to the trail. I cut the fence and created a gate 9/14/16.

Within a short period of time a full dumpster of construction waste, household garbage, a used oil filter, oily rags, garden rubbish and soil, metal fencing, barbed wire, fence posts, etc was deposited directly on the trail. I sorted and removed (as best I could) the worst of the waste.

This area drains directly into the Fay Slough / Humboldt Bay watershed.

On 3/2/2017 I stopped Shannon of Hooven Construction (truck ca 589889, trailer ca 4KN8368) from dumping another fully-loaded dumpster/trailer on the trail. This was done at the direction of Travis Schneider / Ryan Bode.

Most recently, the illegally built road completely destroyed a section of the established trail.

Travis Schneider has demonstrated over and over that he will do as he pleases regardless. The numerous violations of his original permits should be evidence enough.

It has been difficult to witness the blatant disregard for county, state, and tribal regulations put in place to protect what I think is a very important environmental asset.

Recently I have become aware of the extent of the historical evidence for the Tribal Cultural Resource.

Because of the damage done to the trail by the illegally built road any permits need to include restoring the section of the trail destroyed back to its previous condition.

Because of the repeated violations of my deeded access rights, it is necessary they be protected from further interference.

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
