WHEREAS, due to their military experience, veterans possess a wide variety of valuable qualities, including experience, maturity, leadership, and loyalty; and

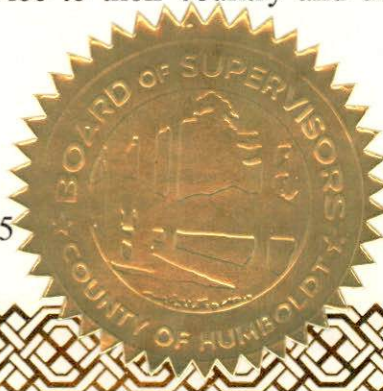
WHEREAS, the County of Humboldt is committed to ensuring that veterans receive the respect and honor they have earned.
