POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE _____ ADOPTING THE AMENDMENTS TO SECTIONS 312-1 THROUGH 312-14 AND REPEALS SECTION 312-32 OF CHAPTER 2 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.

On Tuesday, January 30, 2024, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance _____ which amends Chapter 2 of the Zoning Ordinance. The amendments to Chapter 2 of the Zoning Ordinance creates a ministerial Administrative Permit type approvable by the Planning Director, adds an allowance for renewal of development permits, creates a process for suspension of development permits by the Planning Director, adds cost recovery provisions for revocation proceedings and certain inspections, and removes supplemental coastal zone findings for bed and breakfast establishments. This ordinance amends sections 312-1.2, 312-1.3, 312-3.3, 312-6, 312-6.3, 312-6.5, 312-6.7, 312-9.1, 312-10.2, 312-10.3, 312-14; adds Section 312-10.6; and repeals section 312-32.2 of Chapter 2 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code.
