DISCUSSION:

The continued drought in California and the Western US and the associated rise in animal feed costs is putting many organic dairies at risk of going out of business. Many producers are currently selling off animals to generate cash to cover expenses; an unsustainable long-term strategy for any dairy farm. Without targeted assistance from the government in the form of emergency funding, we could lose many of these agricultural producers forever and lose a vital element of our food system and rural communities. Furthermore, if this issue persists, we could see a possible food shortage emerge in our communities similar to the period during the height of the Covid pandemic. It is imperative that we mobilize funding assistance as soon as possible before the organic dairy industry faces catastrophe.
