DISCUSSION:

The Humboldt County Library (HCL) is fortunate to have received \$204,213 in monetary contributions but it is also privileged to have more than 200 dedicated volunteers who regularly come to the County Library to donate their time and work to help the Library serve the Humboldt County community. Also, one of the essential supporters of HCL is the Humboldt Library Foundation (HLF) whose board of directors tirelessly raise funds to enable the work of

the County Library to provide new materials and services to members of the County. The dedicated work of the HLF has helped the County Library maintain a relevant collection of materials and provide new services in the residents.

Also the support of local foundations is also deeply appreciated. In the Eel River Valley the Rose Perenin Foundation and the McLean Foundation provide generous support to the County library branch sites in Fortuna and in Rio Dell, and their annual support as well as from the Humboldt Sponsor help to enrich the County Library's annual Summer Reading program by providing funds for programming and supplies.

In addition, all of the branch sites have active members of their own Friends of the Library who give their time freely to support their local branch library. And at the Eureka Main Library the Friends of the Redwood Libraries (FORL) maintain a small bookstore called Serendipity and all of the proceeds from book sales are contributed to support the County Library. Furthermore, the County Library depends upon the support and dedicated service of volunteer docents at the Main Library's Humboldt Room to work with the public and keep the doors of the County Library's local history room. It is through the dedication of volunteers at all of the library sites who insure the orderly return of borrowed materials. In the past year in excess of 31,000 volunteer hours of devoted service to the County Library which is vital in supporting the HCL.

In addition to the listings in the attachment to this agenda item, donations less than \$200 make up the difference in the total of \$204,213 and the listing provided in Attachment 1. The generosity in giving to the Library | 2014-15 enabled an additional \$77,000 for book purchases during the year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All monetary donations in this report, amounting to \$204,213 have been received and deposited into either Fund 1500 budget, Unit 621 or Fund 9680, Library Memorials Trust. The Library budget for 2015-16 included estimated donations and so a supplemental budget adjustment is not necessary at this time.
