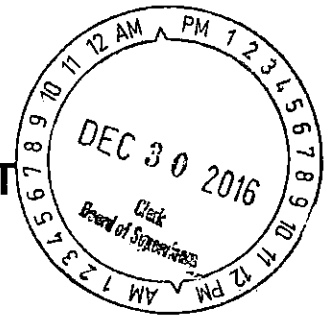

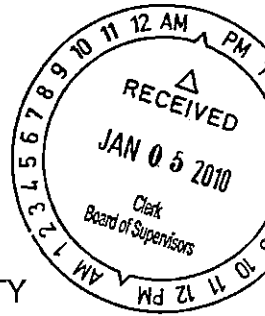

He received the Restoration Award of the year in 1995 from the Humboldt Chapter of the American Fisheries Society, and the Restorationist of the Year for 2005 from the Alliance For Sustainable Jobs and the Environment.

Mr. Madrone provides technical assistance to watershed groups, tribes, and agencies, throughout the country, including help with site planning and assessment, budgets and contracting, project development and implementation. Funding for this work comes from the Ford Foundation and the National Forest Foundation.
