### **DISCUSSION:**

The Humboldt County Library (HCL) is fortunate to have received \$180,265 in monetary contributions but it is also privileged to have more than 200 dedicated volunteers who regularly

come to the County Library to donate their time and work to help the Library serve the Humboldt County community. In addition, one of the essential supporters of HCL is the Humboldt Library Foundation (HLF) whose board of directors tirelessly raise funds to enable the work of the County Library to provide new materials and services to members of the county. The dedicated work of the HLF has helped the County Library maintain a relevant collection of materials and provide new services to the residents of Humboldt County.

The support of local foundations is deeply appreciated. In the Eel River Valley, the Rose Perenin Foundation and the McLean Foundation provide generous support to the County Library branch sites in Fortuna and Rio Dell. Their annual support, along with support from the Humboldt sponsors, helps to enrich the County Library's annual Summer Reading program by providing funds for programming and supplies.

In addition, all of the branch sites have active members of their own Friends of the Library who give their time freely to support their local branch library. At the Eureka Main Library the Friends of the Redwood Libraries (FRL) maintain a small bookstore called Serendipity and all of the proceeds from book sales are contributed to support the County Library. Furthermore, the County Library depends upon the support and dedicated service of volunteer docents at the Main Library's Humboldt Room to work with the public and keep the doors of the County Library's local history room open. It is the dedication of volunteers at all of the library sites which insures the orderly return of borrowed materials. In the past year, the more than 41,000 volunteer hours of devoted service to the County Library was vital in supporting the HCL.

In addition to the \$170,715 in donations detailed in the attachment to this agenda item, there were donations of less than \$200, equaling \$9550, to bring the total of donations received during fiscal year 2015-16 to \$180,265.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All monetary donations in this report, amounting to \$180,265 have been received and deposited into either Fund 1500 budget unit 621 or Fund 9680, Library Memorials Trust. The Library budget for 2016-17 includes estimated donations and therefor, a supplemental budget adjustment is not necessary at this time.
