3. Direct the Auditor-Controller to establish a new contract account 1200321-0334 and transfer \$175,875.00 from 1200321-2118 to the new contract account per the attached appropriation transfer.

On June 19, 2018, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the above-referenced project for bids. On July 10, 2018, the county received six (6) bids for the project. The results are as follows:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This project is being funded by FEMA Disaster funds. FEMA will cover 75 percent of the project costs, and Cal OES will cover 75 percent of the remaining 25 percent of project costs. The Road Fund will cover the remaining 6.25 percent of costs. Construction costs are included in the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Road Fund Budget. This item has no impact on the General Fund.

This project conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Core Role of providing for and maintaining infrastructure as identified in the Board's Strategic Framework.
