Based on the samples they have recommended a water system that will address the high iron content currently found in our water system. We have previously made investments to well infrastructure such as a new electrical system that is safe to run the pump house. We are aware of cultivation best practices and this funding would help to improve our agricultural source of water. Word Limit: 250 We currently have a provisional license from State and and county. However we have completed everything in our compliance agreement except the final electrical walk through inspection of our AG exempt greenhouses. This inspection should happen in the next couple of weeks or months. Once this is complete we will have a final annual county and state license. Also i would like to note we submitted an earlier request for funding but i was mistaken as to the limitation of 10,000 per applicant. I basically misread the part that said cooperatives and road maintenance associated were eligible for more funding.
