Dear Planning Commissioners

This project and the conditions under which it may be operated or maintained **WILL** be detrimental to the public health, safety or public welfare.

If the roundabout is constructed, it will bring traffic close to school children at school. The roundabout would bring northbound and the southbound traffic turning onto Jacoby creek road within 35 feet of the school children at Mistwood School.

Numerous studies have shown the ill effects that roadways have on children's health and learning abilities.

Road traffic exposes children to exhaust and volatile organic compounds, vibration, noise, all of which impede to some degree the learning abilities and health of children.

Moving the road closer to the children at school could adversely affect both the children's health and ability to learn, as well as their safety from moving vehicles.

This is an extremely serious potential adverse effect on small children, which needs to be recognized and addressed, which it has not.
