RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVENUE OF THE GIANTS AND CONTROLLED TRAFFIC ON THE MATTOLE ROAD FOR SIX RIVERS RUNNING CLUB'S 48TH ANNUAL AVENUE OF THE GIANTS MARATHON, HALF MARATHON AND 10K RACE ON SUNDAY, MAY 5, 2019

WHEREAS, the Six Rivers Running Club is planning the 48th Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon, Half Marathon, and 10K Race for Sunday, May 5th, 2019 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., and is requesting that the following specific sections of closure and control are:

1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to 6.55 miles south of Dyerville Bridge closed to all traffic but official race and emergency vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home would be allowed to pass; and
2. Both lanes of the Mattole Road controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.
