As someone who lived next door to this parcel, I, personally, complained to the workers about their grow lights lighting up the hillside at night (which had been the cause of multiple "fire" calls) and about the ridiculously loud music they would play every morning.

The damages to the road caused by water trucks (non-potable water) visiting this property 2-3 times a day during the summer months is another huge issue as this properties workers/owners do not contribute to the community road work and seem to have no qualms about diverting water.

There have been multiple complaints made against this "farm".
