POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE COASTAL SHORT-TERM RENTAL ORDINANCE BY ADOPTING SECTION 313-60.05; AMENDING SECTIONS 313-6, 313-50.1.4.2, 313-55.4.10.6, 313-137, 313-138, 313-141, 313-143, 313-154, 313-163.1.3, 313-172.18, 313-177.10, AND 313-177.14; AND DELETING SECTIONS 313-44 AND 313-172.2 OF CHAPTER 3 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.
On Tuesday, January 30, 2024, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance which adopts the Coastal Short-term Rental Ordinance. The Coastal Short-term Rental Ordinance allows for the legal operation of Short-term Rentals while protecting the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the coastal unincorporated areas of Humboldt County, preserving housing stock, protecting neighborhood quality, supporting tourism and economic development, and balancing the needs of property owners, tenants and neighbors. This ordinance also eliminates Bed and Breakfast provisions and updates definitions. This ordinance adds section 313-60.05, amends sections 313-6, 313-50.1.4.2, 313-55.4.10.6, 313-137, 313-138, 313-141, 313-143, 313-154, 313-163.1.3, 313-172.18, 313-177.10, and 313-177.14, and repeals sections 313-44, and 313-172.2 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code.
