



# HUMBOLDT BAY TRAIL FUND

## *About the Humboldt Bay Trail Fund*

The Humboldt Bay Trail Fund was established in 2017 to provide financial support for the creation and maintenance of multi-purpose trails around Humboldt Bay for walking, running, biking, and wheeling. The fund is administered by the Humboldt Area Foundation to generate investment earnings. Fund development is supported by a working group of community trail advocates. Decisions to allocate funds are made by the Humboldt Bay Trail Fund Committee which is composed of four community members and public agency representatives from the City of Arcata, City of Eureka, and County of Humboldt.

### Highlights:

- The fund balance at the end of 2019 was \$371,725.
- The fund has received over 450 donations from individuals, families, businesses, and other organizations along with many hundreds of donations from promotional events at Eureka Natural Foods, Wildberries, and other venues.
- A total of \$13,150 has been allocated from the fund to support the Volunteer Trail Stewards program in assisting with maintenance on Arcata's Humboldt Bay Trail segment and the Eureka Waterfront Trail.
