This Task Order issued pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Professional Services Agreement dated January 27, 2021, by and between the County of Humboldt, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and HUDSPETH AND ASSOCIATES, INC., AN ASRC INDUSTRIAL SERVICES COMPANY, a Colorado corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR," is intended to supplement the terms and conditions contained in the Professional Services Agreement:

WHEREAS, the definitions, terms and conditions set forth in the Professional Services Agreement dated <u>January 27</u>, 20<u>21</u>, are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full and shall be fully binding upon the parties hereto; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding anything contained herein, any and all definitions, terms and conditions contained in the Professional Services Agreement shall control to the exclusion of any different, contrary or conflicting definitions, terms or conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

- A. <u>Abatement Services</u>. CONTRACTOR shall supply the necessary equipment, materials and personnel to remove all solid waste and junk vehicles from the property. The contents of the residence will not be removed. The contents of the outbuildings will not be removed unless it is determined they contain putrescible solid waste and the putrescible solid waste can be separated from the other debris for disposal. The CONTRACTOR shall properly dispose of all solid waste located on the property. The CONTRACTOR shall secure the residence by installing plywood over the entrances and windows.
- C. <u>Deliverables</u>. The property will be free and clear of the solid waste and junk vehicles in the front and rear yards.
- D. <u>Acceptance Criteria</u>. The property will be free and clear of solid waste, litter and debris. A final COUNTY inspection will be scheduled after completion of the abatement to verify the criteria have been met.

2. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:

CONTRACTOR shall submit photographs of prior to and after completion of the abatement of the public nuisances. The CONTRACTOR will provide the COUNTY with quantitative detail regarding the amount of solid waste and debris removed from the property.

3. PROJECT SCHEDULE:

The abatement will begin on or about April 5th or as soon after obtaining the Abatement Warrant as possible.

4. PROJECT BUDGET:

- A. <u>Maximum Amount Payable</u>. The amount to complete the abatement services rendered, pursuant to the terms and definitions of this Task Order will be Seventy-nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-nine and Seventy Two dollars (\$79,599.72).
- B. <u>Schedule of Rates</u>. See Professional Services Agreement.
- C. <u>Payment Schedule</u>. CONTRACTOR will be paid within thirty (30) days after completion and acceptance of the work and after providing an itemized invoice to the Humboldt County Planning and Building Department following said completion of work.
