Health and Human Services is requesting that the Board of Supervisors approve continuance of the acting supervisor salary until the position is filled.

This re-assignment will enable the Medical Therapy Unit to run effectively during the recruitment process for a new Supervising Therapist.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The estimated cost of additional compensation, from Class 0534 Range 486 to Class 0940 Range 493, for the period of January 17, 2016 to June 30, 2016 is \$3,503. These costs will be covered with salary savings from the vacant position of Supervising Therapist in Fund 1175, Budget Unit 460 Public Health Personnel in fiscal year 2015-16. There will be no impact to the General Fund.

Approving this recommendation will support the Board's Strategic Framework by providing and maintaining infrastructure and by creating opportunities for improved safety and health.
