**POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_ EXTENDING THE INLAND SAFE PARKING-SAFE SHELTER PILOT PROGRAM BY AMENDING SECTIONS 314-61.05 AND 314-61.05.1 OF CHAPTER 4 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.**

On Tuesday, \_\_\_\_\_, 2024, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_ which amends the Inland Safe Parking-Safe Shelter Pilot Program Ordinance to extend the duration of the ordinance from 18 months to a total of 42 months, unless extended moreover. The program allows a government agency, religious institution, non-profit charitable organization, or private non-profit organization to provide homeless individuals and families living in a vehicle or outside a safe place to park or sleep at no cost while accessing services to end their homelessness. This ordinance amends sections 314-61.05, and 314-61.05.1 in Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code.
