RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Receive and file the bids for the High Reflectivity Striping Project on Freshwater Road (6F060) at Post Mile 0.0 to 3.0 and on Kneeland Road (6F060) at Post Mile 27.0 to 37.0.
2. Award the contract to Central Striping Service, Inc., for the total amount of \$189,700.00.
3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to execute the project agreement upon submittal of the appropriate bonds and insurance.
4. Direct the Auditor-Controller to establish a new contract account 1200321-0328 and transfer \$240,000 from 1200321-2118 to the new contract account per the attached appropriation transfer.

DISCUSSION:

On August 15, 2017, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the above-referenced project for bids. On September 19, 2017, the county received two (2) bids for the project. The results are as follows:

1. Central Striping Service, Inc., Rancho Cordova, CA	Base Bid	\$ 183,200.00
	Additive Option A	\$ 6,500.00
2. Sierra Traffic Markings, Inc., Roseville, CA	Base Bid	\$ 279,900.00
	Additive Option A	\$ 18,000.00

Anticipated construction costs for the project are as follows:

Construction (Base Bid + Additive Option A)	\$ 189,700.00
Contingencies (10%)	\$ 18,970.00
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Subtotal	\$ 208,670.00
Construction Administration (15%)	\$ 31,330.00
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TOTAL	\$ 240,000.00

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This project is being funded through the California Department of Transportation Highway Safety Improvement Program, which will provide 100% of construction funding using toll credits in lieu of non-federal matching funds. Construction costs were included in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Road Fund Budget. This action will not affect the General Fund.

This project conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Core Role of providing for and maintaining infrastructure as identified in the Board's Strategic Framework.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board may choose not to award the contract; however, staff does not recommend this alternative because this project will provide thirteen (13) miles of high reflectivity traffic striping using funds that would not otherwise be available to the county.
