SUBJECT: Certification of the November 5, 2024, General Election Results

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept the Certified Statement of Results of the Official Canvass for the November 5, 2024, General Election.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

This action supports the following areas of your Board's Strategic Plan.

Area of Focus: Core Services/Other Strategic Plan Category: 9999 - Core Services/Other

DISCUSSION:

Immediately upon the close of the polls on Election Day, the county elections office begins the canvass of the vote. The activities undertaken during the official canvass include:

- 1. Processing and counting any valid vote by mail and provisional ballots not included in the election night totals;
- 2. An inspection of all materials and supplies returned by poll workers;
- 3. A reconciliation of the number of signatures on the precinct roster with the number of ballots recorded on the ballot statement;
- 4. A reconciliation of the number of ballots counted, spoiled, or rejected due to damage;
- 5. Counting any valid write-in votes;
- 6. Reproducing any damaged ballots, if necessary;
- 7. Conducting a hand count of the ballots cast in one percent of the precincts; and
- 8. Reporting the final results as required.

Elections Code, Section 15372(a), requires the county elections official to complete the official canvass no later than the 30th day after the election and submit a certified statement of the results to the governing body, the County Board of Supervisors.

The approximate cost of the election is \$550,000 and has been allocated within the Elections budget, 1100140, for fiscal year 2024-25.
