<b>ORDINANCE BY AMENDING SECTION 313-87.3</b>	3 OF CHAPTER 3 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III
OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.	

On Tuesday, October 7, 2025, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors repealed Ordinance 2736 and adopted Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_ which adopts the Coastal Sign Ordinance as modified by the California Coastal Commission.

The California Coastal Commission certified the Coastal Signs Ordinance on July 11, 2025 with the suggested changes set forth in its Adopted Findings report. This Ordinance incorporates the modifications suggested by the Coastal Commission to the Coastal Signs Ordinance.

The Ordinance repeals the previously adopted Ordinance 2736 in its entirety; amends Section 313-87.3 of Chapter 3 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code, all relating to Signs within the Coastal Zone (Coastal Signs Ordinance). The Planning Department will notify the Coastal Commission of the County's acceptance of the Commission's suggested modifications and Commission Executive Director will determine whether the acceptance is consistent with the Commission's action. If so, the Executive Director will report the determination to the Commission at the next regularly scheduled public meeting, at which point the modified Ordinance will become effective.
