SECTION 1.	Section 224-2 of Chapter 4 of Division 2 of Title II of the Humboldt County Code is amended as shown on Attachment A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.	
SECTION 2.	This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from the date of its passage. A summary shall be published at least five (5) days before the date set for adoption and again fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance. It shall be published once with the names of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Humboldt, State of California.

ATTACHEMENT A

224-2. Appointment of Regular Members of Commission.

The Commission shall consist of fifteen members. The Supervisor of each district shall appoint three (3) two (2) members. The three (3) two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 1, 2 and 3 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date when the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1998 2026. The three (3) two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 4 and 5 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1995 2028. All subsequent appointments to fill vacancies which result from the expiration of a term of office shall be for a term of four (4) years from and after the expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is being made. Persons appointed to fill a vacancy which results from an event other than expiration of a term of office shall serve until expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is made.
