Post-Adoption Summary of Small Cultivator Amendments to the
Commercial Cannabis Land Use Ordinance (CCLUO), amending
Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code
For Areas Outside the Coastal Zone

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

(To be published within fifteen days after adoption of this ordinance.)

On October 6, 2020, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. _____.

These amendments modify sections 314-55.4.4, 314-55.4.6.1, and 314-55.4.6.5 of Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the Humboldt County Code – HCC. These amendments to the Zoning Ordinance will allow a streamlined permitting pathway for cultivation of up to 2,000 square feet of cannabis on parcels with an existing home. The ordinance applies to areas outside of the Coastal Zone and shall become effective 30 days after adoption.
