

**SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF THE
ORDINANCE**

SUMMARY

On Tuesday, October 6, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 9 of Division 1 of Title VII of the Humboldt County Code, sections 719-4, 719-6, 719-7 and 719-12, relating to the Commercial Marijuana Cultivation Tax Ordinance.

Amendments to the Commercial Marijuana Cultivation Tax Ordinance are intended to ensure that commercial cannabis taxes due in any given year will be paid on a timely basis. This ordinance is intended to restore the provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 1 of Title VII of the Humboldt County Code as they read before the adoption of Ordinance No. 2575 and to eliminate references suggesting property owners who are not permitted cannabis cultivators have an obligation to pay the tax due under that chapter.
