## 민민민민민민민민민민민 **PROCLAMATION** BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT WHEREAS, the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. achieved worldwide recognition as a leader of the American civil rights movement which sought, through nonviolent means, to bring about social, political, and economic equality for Black Americans; and WHEREAS, Dr. King's eloquent leadership inspired supporters throughout the nation to engage in marches, demonstrations, and boycotts to protest racial discrimination; and WHEREAS, those efforts contributed to the enactment of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965; and WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, Jr. was awarded the 1964 Nobel Peace Prize for leading the struggle for racial equality through nonviolent means; and WHEREAS, in contradiction to the nonviolence which he so fervently espoused, King's own life was ended by an assassin's bullet on April 4, 1968; and WHEREAS, Dr. King was an exemplary model of courage, integrity, and dedication to high ideals, an example to all in meeting the challenges of life. **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Monday, January 20, 2014 as "MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.
