Dear Senator McGuire:

On behalf of the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, I am writing in full support of the efforts to honor the memory of Officer Raymond Quincy Mills who was a police officer on the Fortuna Police Department. Officer Mills was tragically killed while on duty March 12, 1967 in an accident where he was fatally struck by a motorist while providing backup during a traffic stop.

We are requesting that a portion of State Highway 101 from Kenmar Road UC# 4-128(PM 59.503) to Palmer Blvd UC# 4-112(PM 62.229) be designated, as the Fortuna Police Officer Raymond Quincy Mills Memorial Highway in memory of Officer Mills. The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors fully supports this effort to honor Officer Mills and in recognition of the small degree of peace it would bring to the family and community to honor his lifetime work.
