DISCUSSION:

In order to adhere to the Board approved By-Laws for Sempervirens and in order to meet federal statutes, medical staff must go through a credentialing process. The credentialing process also extends to non-County employees as well; which includes contracted medical staff and Locum Tenans. The credentialing process is lengthy and requires hours of research and contacting other agencies to confirm past employment history, medical school verifications, internships and licensing verifications. The employee who is solely responsible for this process will be vacating her position May 1, 2015. It is imperative that Mental Health

be able to have staff trained prior to the current staffs' departure. Ms. Hansen has supported Mental Health Administration since May 2014 while another employee was on approved leave. Ms. Hansen has the experience and program knowledge needed to assist Mental Health with this crucial need while Mental Health goes through the recruitment and hiring process to backfill the upcoming vacancy.

The Department is aware that in accordance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) extra help employees who have been identified as a full time employee under the ACA guidelines will be given the opportunity to enroll in the County's health insurance. Those employees will be identified by using the standard measurement period and associated stability period annual cycle set forth by those guidelines.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Mental Health staff assignment of Ms. Hansen will be funded through Mental Health fund; cost of this extra help position is funded by DHHS-Mental Health revenues from Medicare and Medicaid cost reimbursement and Behavioral Health Realignment allocation. The additional cost of extra help hours in FY 2014-15 is \$6,560. There is sufficient appropriation in Mental Health Administration budget unit 1170-424 due to funded vacant positions for these additional extra help hours.

This action supports the Board's Strategic Framework by providing community-appropriate levels of

service and creating opportunities for improved safety and health.
