Process for Considering a Proposed Name for the new Honeydew Bridge

June 16, 2025

The County will consider naming the new bridge over the Mattole River at Honeydew in accordance with Resolution 95-92, which presents criteria for evaluating the historical significance of a proposed name.

Nominations for naming the new Honeydew bridge can be submitted to the Public Works Department until September 1, 2025.

The submittal should include a cover letter identifying the proposed name and the basis for the nomination. To the extent possible, the submittal should include materials documenting the historical significance of the proposed name.

After September 1, Public Works will review the nominations by conducting additional historical research and checking for potential controversy or objections. This screening process is expected to take approximately two months.

Public Works will bring the received nominations to the Board of Supervisors for a decision at a regular public-noticed meeting, likely in November or December 2025.
