## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT

WHEREAS, Cheri Williams began her career with the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office as a Communications Dispatcher on September 28, 1986; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 1989, Cheri received a letter of Commendation from Lieutenant Frank Vulich for her efforts on February 19, 1989 in her capacity as an Emergency Communications Dispatcher. The incident involved a clerk who had been shot twice during a robbery at Circle K Market. In the Commendation, Cheri was cited for her excellent handling of all emergency communications during this critical incident; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2001, Cheri was appointed as Acting Emergency Communications Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2002, Cheri was promoted to the position of Senior Emergency Communications Dispatcher; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2003, Cheri received a Letter of Appreciation from Sheriff Gary Philp for her initiative in the revision of General Orders regarding firearms entries and compliance with new state regulations; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2007, Cheri was promoted to Emergency Communication's Supervisor, in charge of the Dispatch Center and all Emergency Communications Dispatchers; and

WHEREAS, during her 30 years of service, Cheri competently carried out her duties in a very stressful atmosphere. Cheri always considered the welfare of the public and safety of the deputies assigned to a myriad of high profile and dangerous calls for service. She never wavered in her resolve and will always be considered an excellent employee and friend.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, Sheriff Mike Downey and the staff of the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office hereby commends and thanks Emergency Communication's Supervisor Cheri Williams for her dedicated 30 years of service to the citizens of Humboldt County and wish her a long, productive, well deserved retirement.
