RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accepts the completed contract, including all change orders approved by the Public Works Department, between RP Rice Construction, Inc., and Humboldt County for the storm damage repairs on Alderpoint Road.
2. Approves the final claim for payment, as submitted by the Public Works Department to the Auditor/Controller, in the amount of \$2,131.87. This will bring the total amount paid to 100 percent of the contract.

This portion of the road was damaged in the 2005-2006 disaster period. The county made temporary repairs to reopen the road until permanent repairs could be made. The proposed permanent repair consisted of constructing a stabilization trench at each site with temporary detour, replacing culverts, and restoring the roadway.

On March 10, 2015, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the above-referenced project for bids. On April 14, 2015, the County received ten (10) bids for the project. The project was awarded to RP Rice Construction, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder on May 5, 2015. The award amount was \$196,963.35. Change orders through project completion amounted to an increase of \$18,224.36.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Total construction costs for this project were \$215,187.71. This project is being funded through the Federal Highway Administration, which will provide eighty-eight point fifty-three percent (88.53%). The County is funding the remaining eleven point forty-seven percent (11.47%) of the project costs. Construction costs are included in the FY 2015-16 Road Fund Budget.

This project conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Core Role of providing for and maintaining infrastructure as identified in the Board's Strategic Framework.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Not approve the project; however, staff does not recommend this alternative as this project will reconstruct a damaged portion of roadway, using funds that would not otherwise be available to the county.


